Beckstoffer Las Piedras Vineyard - Napa Valley

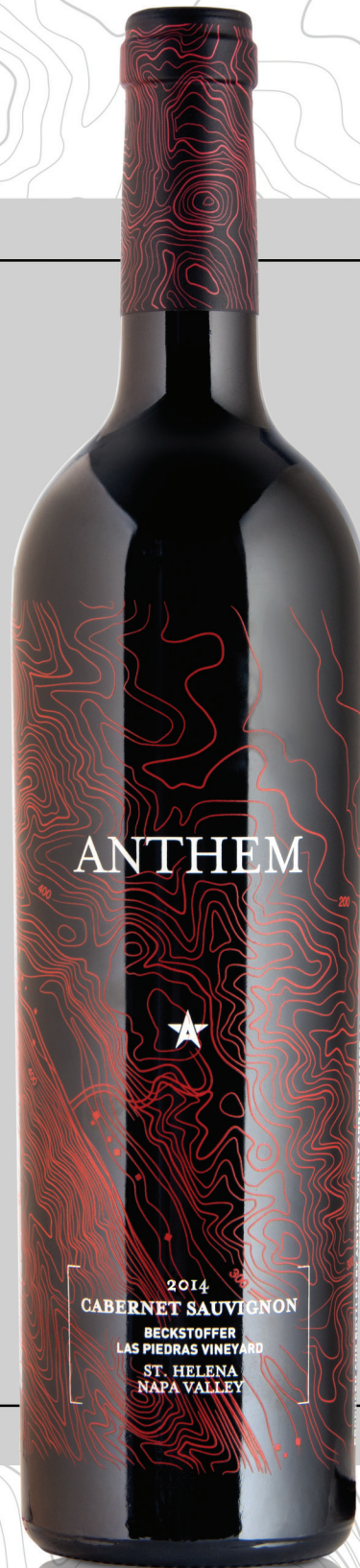
The 2014 Las Piedras Vineyard is managed by Beckstoffer and is one of their six heritage vineyards in the Napa Valley, planted to vine for over 150 years. This 25 acre vineyard produces only Cabernet Sauvignon and is located in West Saint Helena at the base of the Mayacamas Mountains. The vineyard takes its name from the gravelly river washed soil, Las Piedras translates to "little pebbles", in Spanish.

On the palate, it is full weight with plenty of dark fruit, espresso bean, and dark chocolate with a touch of oak, and a long, complex finish.
